









Front View:





Seat and top plates are fabricated from a 14-guage plate, precision punched with a 3/4" hole to create the punched hole pattern. The understructure/attachment plates are fabricated from 10-guage x 1-1/2" flat bar. Top is additionally supported to the outer frame with 10-guage x 1-1/2" flat bar. Top s additionally supported to the outer frame with 10-guage x 1-1/2" flat bar. Blectrically MIG welded.
Coating:	Oven fused functionalized polyethylene copolymer-based thermoplastic. Fluidized bed coating application with superior mechanical performance, impact resistance and UV-stability.
Frame:	1-5/8" O.D. x 14-gauge pre-galvanized structural steel tubing. Cross braces 1" O.D. x 16- guage pre-galvanized steel tubing. Brace attachment points 1-1/2" x 2" x 3/16" steel flat bar. Top mountings points are 7-gauge 2" x 2" die formed angle. Seat mounting points are 7-guage x 1-1/2" die tamped steel flat bar. Legs are bent over mandrel through the bend radius producing a wrinkle free bend. All electrically MIG welded.
Frame Coating:	Electrostatic powder coated application oven cured.
Hardware:	All stainless-steel hardware fasteners.
Dimensions:	Top is 46" x 55" x 30" high. Seats are 10" wide x 36" long x 18-1/4" high. Outside to outside dimensions of 3 seat accessible table is 76-3/4" x 70".


